

Faversham Masonic Temple

Access to the Temple is via Abbey Place – a pedestrian walkway between St Mary’s Church and Queen Elizabeth Grammar School. The paths are generally flat but lighting isn’t fabulous so you may need a torch after the Festive Board to successfully navigate the paths.

Parking near the Temple is limited and enforced quite strictly so you may get caught out: please be careful.

We advise against parking at the School – there is a 10pm curfew and the gates are locked and you won’t be able to retrieve your car until the following morning.

Options:

1. Use Standard Quay and visit Baltic House Wine Bar – run by W.Bro. Alan Bartlett. Use ME13 7BS for your SatNav – visit Baltic House and they will book your car registration in to give you free parking. The Temple is a 6-minute walk so arrive early and have a drink in the Wine Bar.
2. Use Church Road (on-street parking) ME13 8AZ for your SatNav – space is limited but it is convenient if you can find a space. The road is narrow and turning round is a challenge!
3. Use Institute Road Car Park – ME13 8EH for your SatNav. Charges apply into the evening so you will need to pay – the temple is a 6-minute walk past the Church.

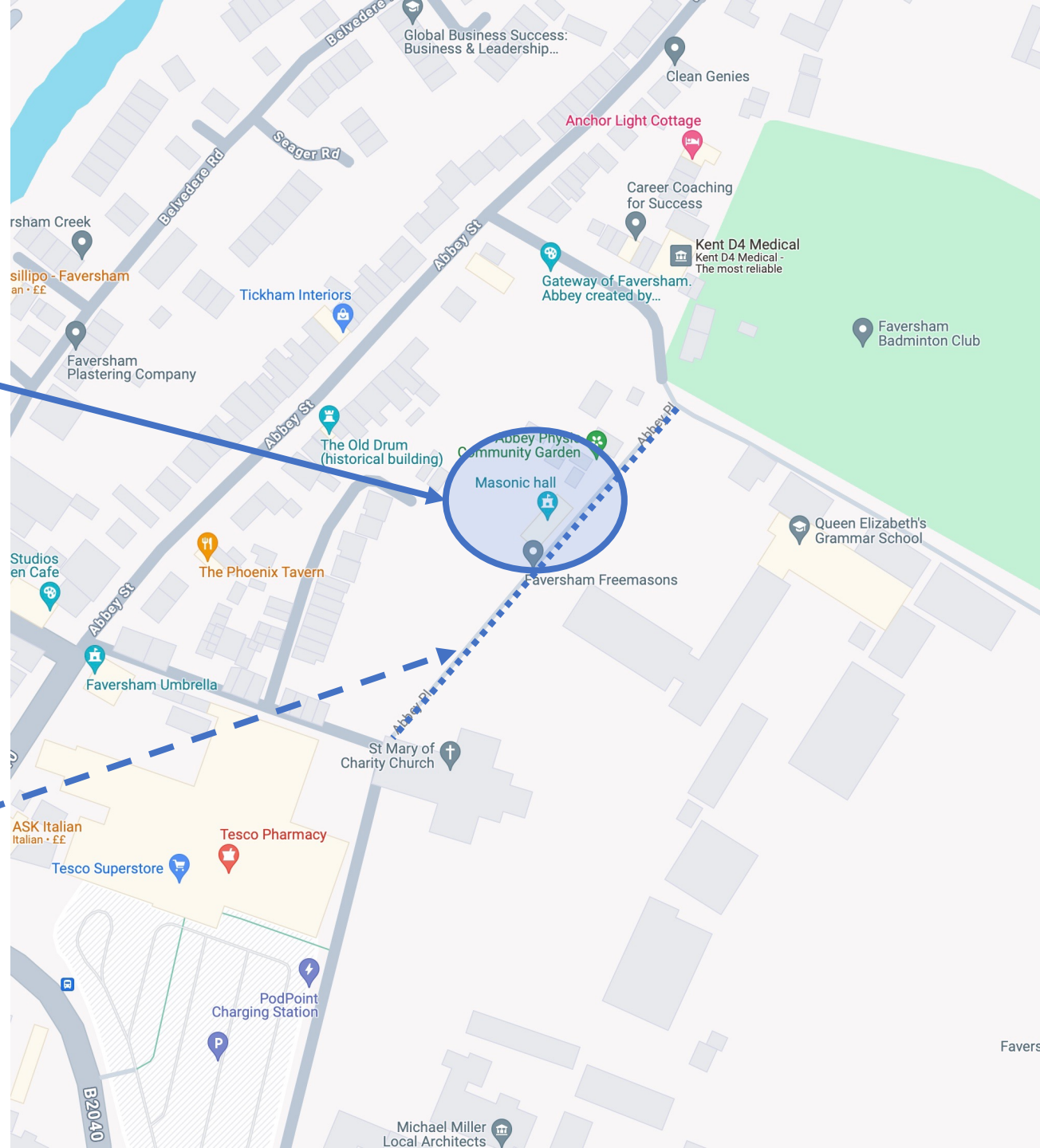

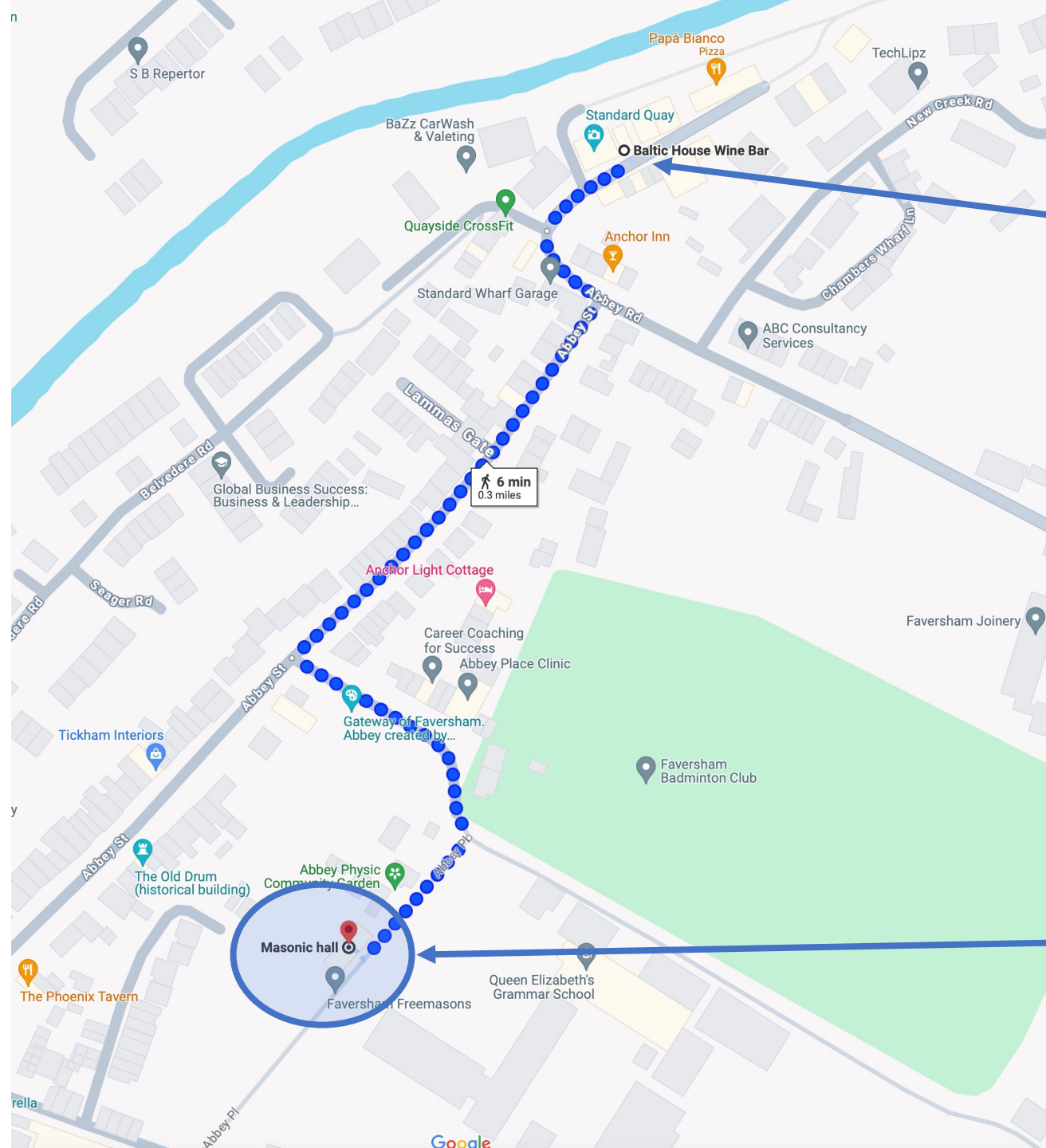

Grammar School



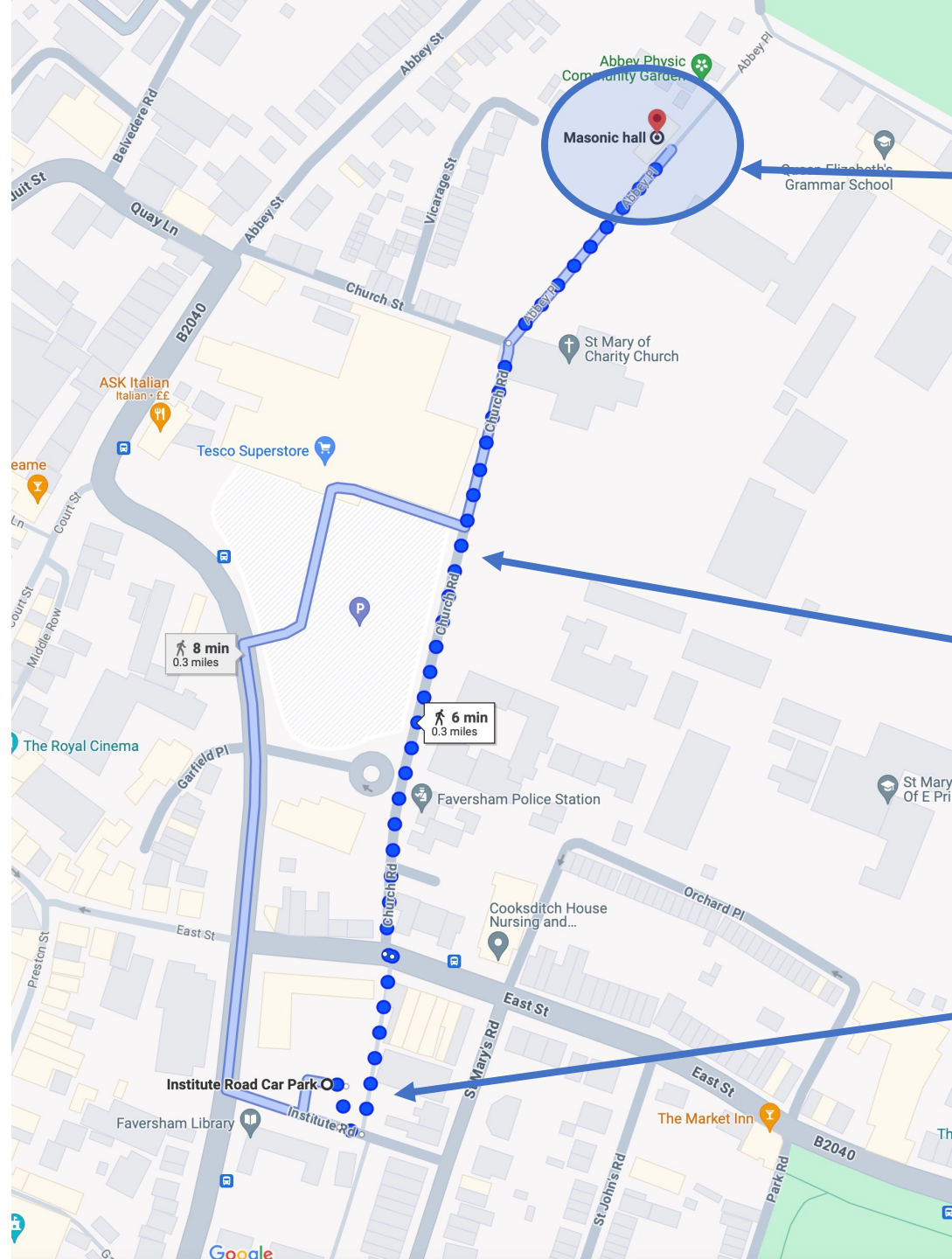


Parking at Standard Quay – ME13 7BS
